F. E. D. Vignette #9 --

Two Alternative Interpretations of

"The Negation of the Negation".

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<u>Author's Preface</u>. The purpose of Vignette **#9** is to present two alternative interpretations of the central <u>dialectical</u> "<u>negation of the negation</u>" process, which are both ambiguously implicit in many discourses that invoke <u>dialectics</u>, but whose differences can be readily 'explicitized' using the F.<u>E.D</u>. First <u>Dialectical</u> Algebra.

I. Preliminary Note: "Negation of Negation" in the Context of the Boolean Algebra for Non-Dialectical Logic.

Boolean Negation is Abstract Negation. If, in the "Primary Interpretation" -- the 'Existential Interpretation' -- per Boole, of Boole's original arithmetic and algebra for formal logic, we select a case in which $\mathbf{x} = \mathbf{1}$, asserting, by that equation, that the «arithmos» or assemblage of Xs, of the X-kind of "logical individuals", i.e., that the category or "class" X, exists, and, indeed, thereby identifying that category with/as 'the universal category', as constituting the entirety of the "universe of discourse", then the Boolean *negation* of that **x**, written **1 - x**, produces *absolute nothingness*, Boole's "Nothing", "0":

$$1-x = 1-1 = 0$$

= the "empty class", the "empty category", the "arithmos" devoid of any monads, devoid of any individuals. That is, by this Boolean operation, modeling formal-logical *negation*, **X**, the "Universe", the "universal class", the "universe of discourse", the "'All" -- "Everything" -- is summarily converted into "Nothing".

Thus, "the negation of the negation", in the context of Boolean, formal, non-dialectical logic, is an utterly flat circular movement, or a "back and forth", oscillatory, "zig-zag" movement, which returns to its starting point; a movement between "Everything", "1", and "Nothing", "0", or between "Nothing", "0", and "Everything", "1", depending upon the "starting point", the initial, X, value --

$$x = 1 - (1 - x)$$

$$0 = 1 - (1 - 0)$$

$$0 = 1 - (1 - 0)$$

 $1 = 1 - (1 - 1)$

-- a movement, that is, which returns to "Nothing", " $\mathbf{0}$ ", if the starting point, \mathbf{x} , is "Nothing", $\mathbf{x} = \mathbf{0}$, and which returns to "Everything", "1", if the starting point is "Everything", $\mathbf{x} = 1$.

II. Two Distinct Meanings for the Phrase "The Dialectical Negation of the Negation".

Key Proposition: Dialectical negation is «aufheben», determinate negation, not "abstract negation" / "absolute negation".

i.e., the <u>dialectical</u> negator of an ontological category, 8, is that ontological category, 8, itself.

Dialectical negation is, primarily, self-negation, self-«aufheben», determinate self-transformation / self-development / self-change / «autokinesis».

The <u>dialectical</u> negation operation for an ontological category, 8, is <u>not</u> an other operation than its operand, is <u>not</u> an<u>other</u> "function" than its "argument", is <u>not other</u> than the self-same ontological category, 8, itself.

The ontological category symbol, \Re , is itself also a *gene*ric symbol for an operation, for an operator, for a function, for a process, for an 'ideo-eventity' -- specifically, for some special kind of «aufheben» operator.

The <u>dialectical</u> negation operator for \bigotimes is \bigotimes itself.

That is, <u>dialectical</u> negation of \bigotimes , \rightleftharpoons , is, in its <u>primary</u> instance, <u>not</u> negation by an <u>external</u> <u>other</u>, not by an <u>alien</u> operation, operator, or category, but is, on the contrary, <u>self-negation</u>, <u>internal</u> <u>negation</u>, <u>immanent</u> <u>negation</u>, that is, a <u>self-movement</u>, a <u>self-induced change</u>, a <u>self-driven process</u>, expressing the <u>dialectical</u> <u>internal contradiction</u>, that is, the <u>self-contradiction</u> -- the '<u>self-duality</u>', or '<u>intra-duality</u>' -- of the category/operation/process/eventity symbolized by \bigotimes , which <u>process</u> expresses <u>not</u> a "propositional [self-]contradiction" of the kind encountered in formal logic, but an '<u>intra-contra-kinesis</u>' of the kind codified by a contental, ontological, existential -- <u>dialectical</u> -- logic.

The equation = \otimes means that the eventity denoted by \otimes becomes its own *negator* when its <u>self-development</u> reaches its critical point, its point of '<u>self-meta-evolution</u>' or of '<u>self-revolution</u>'.

To describe the timing of that <u>self-development</u>, of its reaching its critical point, and of what develops thereafter, requires the richer languages of the [<u>meta-</u>]systematic-<u>dialectical</u> progression of the <u>dialectical</u> ideographies.

Minimally, it requires a language which incorporates at least a discrete-time, or **<u>s</u>**tep-count, Whole-number variable, **s**, such as do the *Seldon Functions*.

In this interpretation, the <u>dialectical</u> negation operator, '-', acts as a kind of 'horizontalized', leftwards "ditto" mark.

This interpretation thus gives rise to the 'Dyadic Seldon Function', which can be expressed, compactly, as follows --

$$\mathbf{H}_{s} = (\mathbf{\hat{x}})^{2^{s}}$$
, wherein, consecutively, $\mathbf{s} = \mathbf{0}, \mathbf{1}, \mathbf{2}, \mathbf{3}, \mathbf{4}, \mathbf{5}, \mathbf{6}, \dots$

-- given that, therein, denotes the earliest, beginning, starting, or original ontological category of the dialectical ontological categories-progression / operators-progression / "functions"-progression / eventities- progression or systems- progression modeled by this 'Dyadic Seldon Function', that is, -- given that denotes the *arché* of that dialectical progression.

This interpretation thus gives rise to the 'Triadic Seldon Function', which can be expressed, compactly, as follows --

$$\mathbf{H}_{s} = (\mathbf{S})^{3^{s}}$$
, wherein, again, consecutively, $\mathbf{s} = \mathbf{0}, \mathbf{1}, \mathbf{2}, \mathbf{3}, \mathbf{4}, \mathbf{5}, \mathbf{6}, \dots$

-- given, again, that, therein, denotes the *earliest*, *beginning*, *starting*, or *original* ontological category of the <u>dialectical</u> ontological *categories-progression* / *operations-progression* / *"functions"-progression* / *eventities- progression* or *systems- progression* modeled by this *"Triadic Seldon Function"*, that is, given that denotes the *arché* of that <u>dialectical progression</u>.

In the <u>Encyclopedia Dialectica</u> research, both of these two interpretations of the core-<u>dialectical</u>, <u>self</u>-<u>«aufheben</u>» process of the '<u>self-negation of the self-negation</u>...', have been found to be useful -- both the <u>Dyadic</u> and the <u>Triadic</u> versions of the <u>Seldon Function</u> have been found useful -- for the formulation of <u>dialectical</u> '<u>meta-models</u>' of the ontological '<u>self-revolutions</u>' of nature, of the '<u>meta-dynamical</u>', '<u>self-meta-evolutionary transitions</u>' from one epoch and regime of dynamical "evolution" to its expanded-ontology successor such epoch.
